Re: 2018–2019 School Calendar

Please find attached the current proposed Calendar for the 2018–2019 School Year titled "August Draft." This calendar represents administration's recommendation following a process of public, school administrator, and district program manager input.

Highlights of the public input include the following:

- The public feedback survey for the April Draft 2018-2019 Academic Calendar was active for the month of May 2017. We received 308 responses. Of the respondents, 73.4% identified as parents/guardians, 20.1% as elementary teachers, 14.6% as secondary teachers, 7.5% as other district employees, and 5.5% as community members. Respondents were allowed to select all affiliations that applied.
- Approximately one third of the feedback focused on the proposed Parent-Teacher Conference dates with strong support from parents and teachers to hold two days of conferences each semester. Many respondents were concerned a single day would not be enough time for teachers to conference with every parent and that teachers would not have time to attend conferences for their own children.
- There was more support for starting the school year mid-week than starting the year with a full week. Respondents supportive of a mid-week start cited benefits of a more gradual transition into the school year.
- Teachers' comments indicated professional development days scheduled for the end of the school year were ineffective and should be held earlier in the school year.
- Approximately a third of the responses provided feedback on the school year start date, end
 date, length and schedule of school breaks, frequency and schedule of early outs, and
 holiday observances. However, the input varied widely and lacked consensus for a single
 course of action.

 - This draft is provided to allow for initial board conversation regarding the potential of a post-Labor Day school start date. The only details addressed in this draft are the year start/end dates. No other dates or details in the draft have been adjusted.
 - Administration recommends that if the board wishes to consider a post-Labor Day start date, that a school year after 2018-2019 be designated the potential start year, and that a full school year be allocated to robust research, input and debate. If the board wishes to consider significant calendar adjustments for future school years, administration may present not only post-Labor Day options but also year-round, trimester, and other models.

Key Points about AUGUST Draft Proposed 2018-2019 Academic Calendar

This calendar meets all the requirements listed in the "School Calendar Guidelines" document for 2018-2019.

FALL SEMESTER

For fall semester, required teacher work days are scheduled for Wednesday, Aug. 8 and Tuesday, Aug. 14.

Students are scheduled to start school on Wednesday, Aug. 15 and end the semester on Thursday, Dec. 20.

There was parent and teacher feedback on the APRIL Draft (with students starting on a Monday) that it was preferred to have the return to school fall mid-week to ease students back into the school schedule.

The feedback also included concerns about the semester ending so close to the Christmas holiday. The AUGUST Draft is adjusted to start mid-week and dismiss on the Thursday, Dec. 20 rather than Friday, Dec. 21.

SPRING SEMESTER

For spring semester, the teacher work day is Monday, Jan. 7.

Students are scheduled to return to school Tuesday, Jan. 8 and end the semester on Friday, May 17. These are the same dates as the APRIL Draft.

This allows for the teacher work day and the three (3) tentative make-up days to be finished before the Memorial Day weekend.

Spring break is scheduled for March 11-15.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT & PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

Out of the 180 student contact days, state statute allows up to ten (10) days per year to be used for professional development and/or parent-teacher conference days and still count as student contact days.

This draft calendar includes 4 days of parent-teacher conference days:

- Fall semester (Oct. 25-26)
- Spring semester (Feb. 18-19).

Feedback to the APRIL Draft calendar, which only included one parent-teacher conference in the spring, was strongly in support of two days per semester.

Of the six (6) allowable professional development days, five (5) are scheduled in the fall semester and one (1) is scheduled in the spring semester:

- Thursday, Aug. 9
- Friday, Aug. 10 (recommended for all teacher Hering/Welcome Back event)
- Monday, Aug. 13
- Friday, Sept. 28
- Monday, Nov. 12 (Veteran's Day)
- Friday, Feb. 1

There are no professional development days scheduled for the end of the school year. Teacher feedback to the APRIL Draft calendar was that training at the end of the school year was less effective due to teachers' end-of-year exhaustion, forgetting training material over the summer break, and personnel changes (disengaged resigning/retiring teachers required to attend training and new teachers not hired yet missing the training).

The AUGUST Draft calendar also includes the three (3) early out staff training days the School Board approved for the 2017-2018 school year. The early outs have been scheduled in the calendar to coordinate with existing professional development days:

- Thursday, Sept. 27
- Friday, Nov. 9
- Thursday, Jan. 31

TESTING

The PEAKS testing window runs from Monday, March 25 through Tuesday, April 30. There is some parent concern about the seemingly long length of the testing window. However, the impact to each student assessed is usually spread over three (3) days. Schools do not all test on the same day, each schools selects their specific testing days for sometime during the testing window.

Guidelines for 2018-2019 School Calendar

Length of School Year

- ✓ The calendar *must* consist of 180 student contact days plus 4 teacher workdays.
- ✓ Professional Development (Inservice) Days **count** as student contact days.
- ✓ Parent-Teacher Conference Days **count** as student contact days when subtracted from the ten (10) Professional Development Days allowed by state statute each year.
- ✓ Teacher Work Days and vacation/holidays **do not count** as student contact days.
- ✓ **Quarters** should be approximately 45 days each.
- ✓ **Semesters** should be balanced at *approximately 90 days* each.
- ✓ Three tentative student contact days should be included in case of school closures due to inclement weather.

Teacher Work Days

The calendar includes four (4) teacher work days when students are not in school, distributed as follows:

2 - before school starts for students

1 - following the end of first semester

1 - following the last day for students

Professional Development (Inservice) Days

No more than ten (10) Professional Development Days are allowed by state statute to count as student contact days. The proposed calendar has six (6) Professional Development Days and four (4) Parent-Teacher Conference days.
