## High School PASS Positive Alternative to School Suspension

A program for secondary  
students who are  
suspended 6 to 10 days



# High School PASS

**PASS** is a voluntary program. There is a 5 day minimum requirement. Students eligible to attend are those who have:

- ❖ 1<sup>st</sup> time violation of the drug and alcohol policy.

***The first violation of the drug and alcohol policy results in a 10 day suspension. Students serve five days out of school, but can attend the PASS program the last five days of the suspension.***

- ❖ Students need to provide their own transportation if a suspension from school bus transportation is in effect.
- ❖ The **PASS** program is a closed campus and district rules apply.
- ❖ Students will need to bring their school books and any assignments or projects they are currently working on at their school.

**\*Note:** *Students attend the program from 8 a.m. – 2 p.m.*

## SERVICES PROVIDED

- ❖ A structured, supervised setting for students during their suspension.
- ❖ Daily social skills group.
- ❖ Individual sessions with an Intervention Specialist, as needed.
- ❖ Coordination of student's schoolwork from the student's teachers.
- ❖ Individual academic support.
- ❖ Information about community services for parents and students.
- ❖ Drug and alcohol assessments provided for a 1<sup>st</sup> time violation.
- ❖ Transition plan for a student to return to regular daily school schedule.
- ❖ Follow-up contact upon a student's return to daily schedule.
- ❖ Behavior risk screening.
