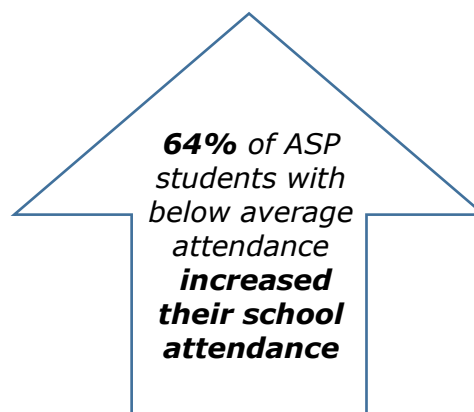
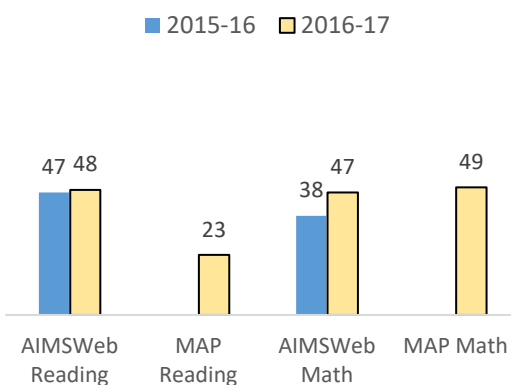


Denali Elementary School After School Program (ASP) Evaluation Results 2016-17



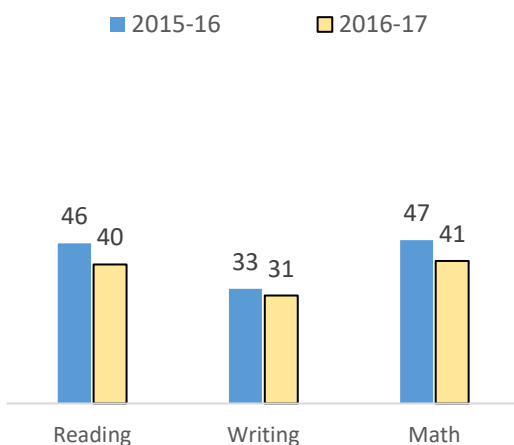
- * Students will improve their academic performance

The After School Program is working toward having 40% of students show growth in **Reading and Math** using **AIMSweb** and **MAP** assessments



80 out of 94 students were enrolled in the ASP for 30 days or more, or 85%.

The ASP is working toward having 50% of ASP students **improve** their **Reading, Writing, and Math Grades**

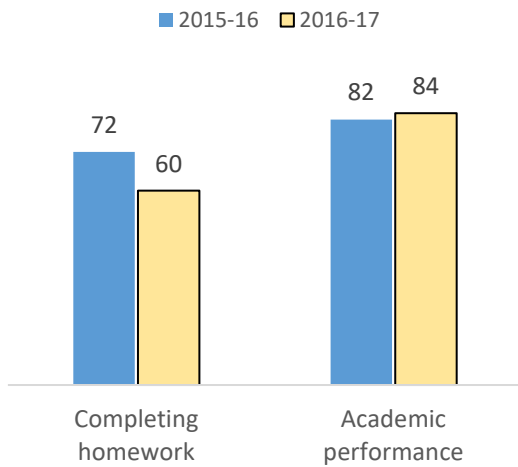

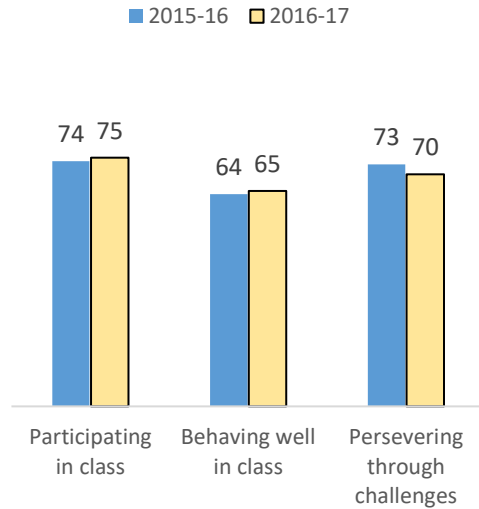

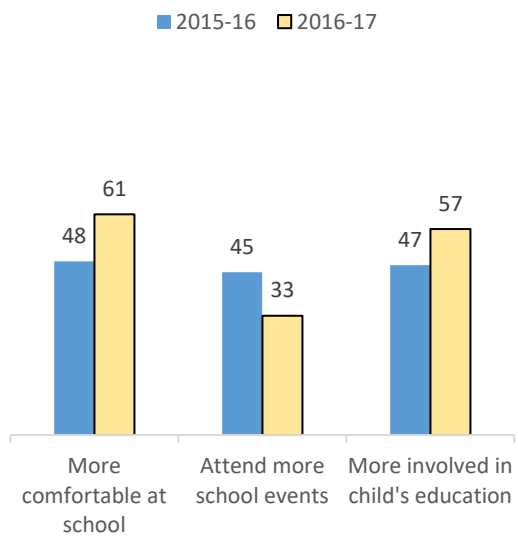
Teachers report a majority of ASP students showed **improvements in academic skills**

70% OF ASP STUDENTS SAY THEY LIKE GOING TO SCHOOL AND 73% SAY THEY LIKE BEING PART OF THE AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM.

74% OF ASP STUDENTS SAY THE ASP HAS HELPED THEM DO BETTER IN SCHOOL.

70% SAY THE PROGRAM HAS HELPED THEM GET ALONG BETTER WITH OTHERS.

86% SAY THEY LIKE THE CHOICES OF CLASSES AND ACTIVITIES OFFERED IN THE ASP.

85% SAY THE TEACHERS AND STAFF IN ASP CARE ABOUT THEM.
