

Elizabeth Peratrovich and Martin L. King Jr.

Venn Diagram Activity/Compare & Contrast

Students will fill in a venn diagram comparing and contrasting the efforts of Elizabeth Peratrovich, Alaska Native Rights advocate, and Martin Luther King Jr., African American Rights advocate.

Kindergarten-12th Grade:

1. Teacher choose hook on first page of packet to introduce lesson.
2. KWL Chart—complete the first 2 segments about each person (E.P. & M.L.K.)
3. Read book/info. or watch video segment on both
4. Complete “Learned” portion of the KWL chart for each person (E.P. & M.L.K.)
5. Have students fill out the Venn Diagram

Extensions for students:

- A. Write a compare and contrast essay focusing on two-three key components of civil rights advocacy.
- B. Write a scene in which Elizabeth Peratrovich and Martin Luther King Jr. had a meeting discussing Civil Rights
- C. Compare and contrast the Civil Rights movement Elizabeth Peratrovich was a part of to what Martin Luther King Jr. was a part of.
