Parent Information

AT Home:

- Consult the [Daily COVID Decision Tree](#)
- Your child has **Symptoms** - **Stay Home**
- Family Member has **Symptoms** - Student **Stays Home**
- Waiting on a COVID Test Result - **Stay Home**

AT School:

- Student becomes symptomatic - Student will be sent home and not allowed back in the building for 10 days
- School will implement contact tracing and notify families
- Students who are a close contact will attend school remotely

Ryan Mitigation Plan

Students & Staff Will:

- Wear a mask at all times (except when eating)
- Wash Hands and/or use Hand Sanitizer Frequently & when moving from place to place
- Wipe down work areas at the end of each class
- Remain with the same group (cohort) all day
- Be escorted to classes
- Have assigned seats in classes
- Locker access, Lunch dismissal, End of day dismissal will be staggered to limit number of students in the hallway at one time
- Follow floor signage when moving throughout the building (changing classes)
- We will be taking daily attendance for all students

Student Information

Non-negotiables

- Follow above Mitigation Plan
- Follow all adult directions
- Phones will need to be off and in your locker
- Locker access during the day will be limited to start/end of day & lunch if brought from home

Being Prepared:

- Gather all supplies during advisory class
- Bring Chromebook and Charger everyday
- Chromebook carrying case
- Charge your Chromebook each night

Supplies Needed:

- 2 masks- one to wear and back up
- Earbuds/ headphones
- Water bottle with straw
- Chromebook (school issued) or Device brought from home (we will help with access to wifi)
- Pencil case with pens, pencils, highlighter, colored pencils, calculator, etc.
- Teachers will let students know what other supplies they need

Breakfast & Lunch

Reimbursable meals are free for all ENROLLED FNSBSD students

- A reimbursable meal is a meal that meets all USDA requirements.
- We can only provide 1 free breakfast and 1 free lunch per student per day.
- USDA Waivers extended free meals to the end of the school year, **May 18th, 2021**

In all areas of the school students will follow mitigation plan outlined above for entering new spaces.

Arrival to School

- Students report to their assigned space (same room for lunch)
- Breakfast- Served from 8:50-9:20am- pick up and take to assigned room
- 9:20am Students escorted to their advisory classes
- 9:20-9:30 Students get ready for the day

Lunch

- 3 lunches
- Staggered released to lunch by cohort
- Follow social distancing while waiting in line
- Report to assigned lunch room
- Teachers will pick up students after lunch for next class

Communication Plan

How **WE** communicate with families:

- If you have not been receiving any communication from the school, please call us so we can get you set up.
- We use email, text messaging and robo-calls
- Weekly Newsletter via email and text messaging
- Post information on the school website, Daily Bulletin and Ryan bitly.

PowerSchool

- If you use PowerSchool you can sign up for the Daily Bulletin and email alerts for attendance and grades
- This is especially helpful if your child is learning remotely and they do not log into class- you will be alerted
- If you do not use PowerSchool call the office and we can help you get set up with your guardian account

If a student is exposed at school we will call all families who may be impacted.

Parent Drop-Off & Pick-Up Information

Morning Drop-off

Please pull up next to the curb so that your student does not need to cross between cars. Use the inside lane next to the curb for drop off and the outside lane for drive through. Students and adults should cross at the cross walk where there is a crossing guard.

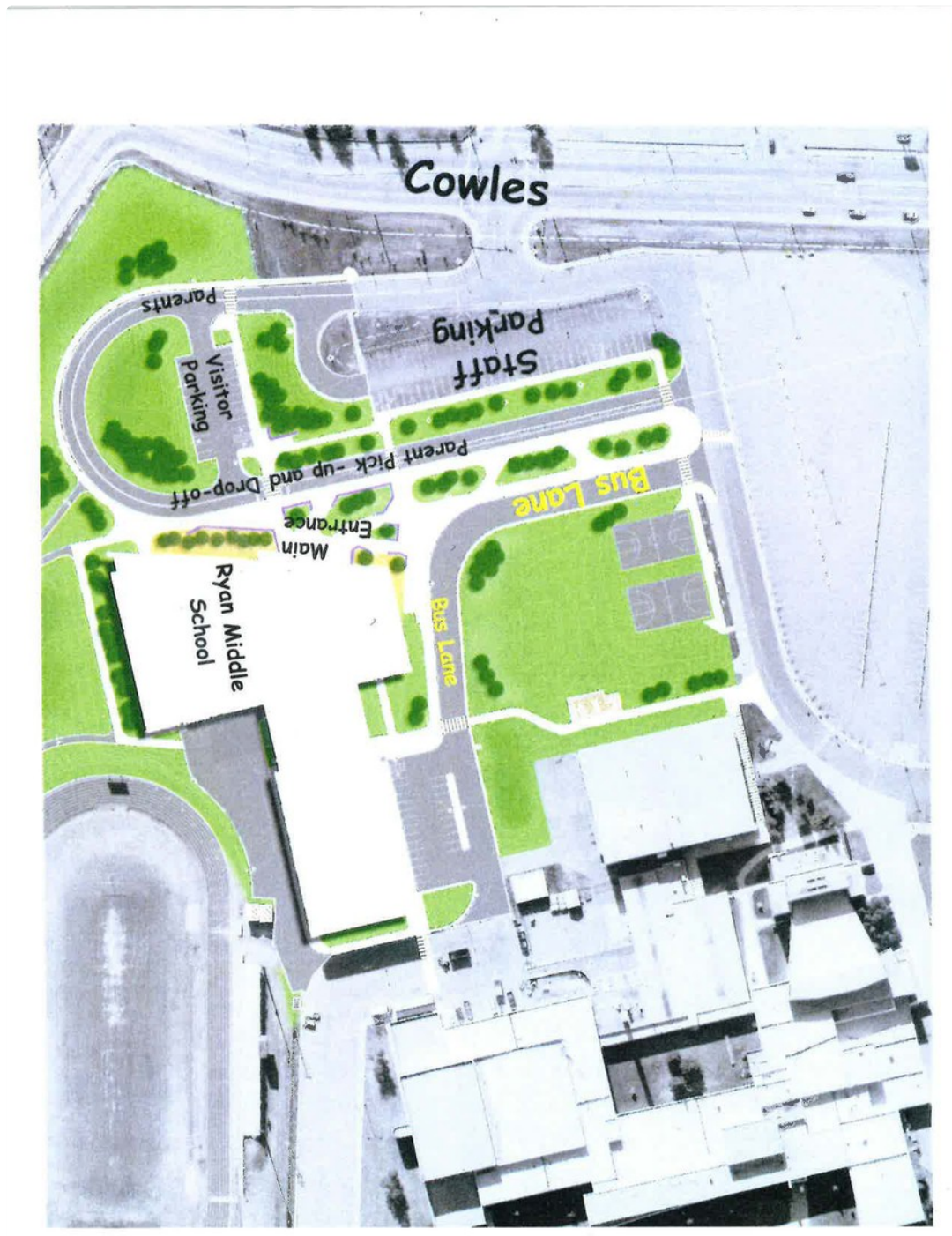
Afternoon Pick-up

Please use the right lane while waiting for school to be dismissed and bumper up close to the car in front of you. When the car in front of you pulls out into the drive through lane, please move up and take their spot. Once your student is in your car, put your signal on and the person at the crossing will wave you into the drive through lane. It is important for your child's safety that you not stop in the drive through lane making your child cross between cars. If everyone uses the right lane and moves up

Visitor Parking

Please do not pull through the visitor parking to pick-up your student. This slows down the traffic flow and often double parks visitors that are trying to leave. This creates a safety concern for students. The visitor parking is designed for guest presenters or families that need to come into the building.

Transportation

Ryan Students will be expected to remain in their assigned seat and wear their mask while riding the bus to and from school.
