Green blocks: The music program typically offers general music to all students two times per week in 30 minute blocks. There is no reduction to the number of minutes for general music.

Blue and purple blocks: For orchestra, there is a recommended minimum number 90 minutes per week for each level), so in this schedule, we are also applying this time to band as an example.

Orange blocks: In addition, the negotiated agreement provides each teacher with 330 minutes of uninterrupted prep time each week (Orange blocks).

White blocks: "Other" is time that a music teacher uses to offer additional sections of music, including small group work for students on specific instruments, groups of students who may have been prevented from participating in band or orchestra because of other individual student and building needs, sections of choir, and tutoring.
