# U.S. DEPT. OF EDUCATION SCHOOL CLIMATE SURVEYS (EDSCLS)

- SY 20-25 Strategic Plan:
  - Core Values
    - Embody respect for the diversity and dignity of all
    - Provide a **safe** learning **environment**
    - **Engage** with students, family, staff, and community to support student success
  - Strategic Goals
    - Student Success: Increase academic achievement and social emotional well-being for all students

# U.S. DEPT. OF EDUCATION SCHOOL CLIMATE SURVEYS (EDSCLS)

- Suite of surveys for students (grades 5-12), parents, and staff
- Reliable, nationally-validated
- Completion time 10-20 minutes (47 to 83 items)
- Majority of survey items provide a positive statement with 4 response options – 2 positive, 2 negative (from Strongly Disagree to Strongly Agree)
- Administered every Spring, 2017 to 2022

## ED SCHOOL CLIMATE SURVEYS

• 3 domains with 13 subdomain topical areas

1. Engagement

2. Safety

3. Environment

## ENGAGEMENT DOMAIN

Strong relationships between students, teachers, families, and schools and strong connections between schools and the broader community.

Topics: Cultural and linguistic competence, Relationships, and School participation

# ENGAGEMENT EXAMPLES

• Teachers understand my problems (students)

At this school, my child feels he/she belongs (parents)

• Staff do a good job helping parents to support their children's learning at home (staff)

## SAFETY DOMAIN

Emotional and physical safety are fundamental characteristics of high-quality schools; in these schools, students feel a sense of belonging and are free to focus on learning

Topics: Emotional safety, Physical safety, Bullying, Substance Abuse, and Emergency readiness/management

# SAFETY EXAMPLES

• I feel safe going to and from this school (students)

• My child is safe at this school (parents)

• People at this school care about me as a person (staff)

## **ENVIRONMENT DOMAIN**

Appropriate facilities, well-managed classrooms, available school-based health supports, and a clear, fair disciplinary policy

Topics: Physical and Instructional environment, physical and mental health, and discipline

# ENVIRONMENT EXAMPLES

• My teachers expect me to do my best all the time (students)

 My child's teachers make themselves available to me (parents)

• Discipline is fair (staff)

## **BENCHMARKS**

• In Fall of 2017, benchmarked scale scores were completed to provide perception levels by domain and topic

• Four levels of perception: Very Positive, Positive, Negative, and Very Negative

• Provided results are percent positive/very positive (positive rate)

## SCHOOL CLIMATE RESULTS

• Publically Available Data Dashboard to review School Climate results:



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#### CONCLUSION

• 2022 Student response rate of 54% vs 40% 2021

• 2022 Parent response rate of 16% vs 24% 2021

• 2022 Staff response rate of 55% vs 67% 2021

#### CONCLUSION

• Greater than 3/4 positive rate for students and staff in Engagement, Safety, and Environment

• Schools given grade point average of 2.86, 3.17, and 3.19 by students, staff, and parents in 2022

• Student positive rate above benchmark in all domains (below benchmark for staff)

#### CONCLUSION

• Perception gaps for all student demographic groups were no more than 'small'

 African American student group had lowest positive rate than all other demographic groups for all 3 domains
