RESOLUTION 2022-17:

RECOGNIZING MONTH OF THE MILITARY CHILD

WHEREAS, military children and youth are a source of pride and honor, it is only fitting we take time to recognize their contributions, celebrate their spirit, and let our men and women in uniform know that while they are taking care of us, we are taking care of their children and youth;
