REGISTRATION, POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

Before School Program

The following policies will ensure that the Good Morning, Tanana program is a positive experience for everyone involved – students, parents, and staff.

ATTENDANCE:

- There are no mandatory attendance requirements for the morning program. Students may attend daily or on a “drop-in” basis as needed. Daily attendance records are kept.
- Students who are not already registered in Good Morning Tanana will be given a Registration, Policies, and Guidelines form the first time they attend to be signed by their parent or guardian. Students will not be allowed back into the program until this form is returned.
- All students will report to the Cafeteria immediately upon entering the building. They should not make trips to their lockers until the bell rings at 9:10.
- Students are considered “present” once they have signed in at the Cafeteria, not when they are dropped off at the school. Passes for the Library, teachers, restroom, etc., will be given to students at the discretion of the Good Morning Tanana staff.
- Attendance in Good Morning, Tanana is a privilege, not a right.

DISCIPLINE:

- Both student and parent understand that this is an enrichment program. Positive attitude and behavior are required, and school rules must be followed.
- All discipline matters will be referred to the Tanana office staff.
- First Offense: A student removed from the morning program with a discipline referral must request in writing to be allowed back into the program. The Good Morning staff will make the final determination.
- Second Offense: Removal from the program – NO EXCEPTIONS.

SAFETY:

- All participating students must have a signed Registration and Consent/Emergency Medical Form on file. Forms are available in the office.
- Remember: A student is considered present for Good Morning Tanana once they have signed in at the cafeteria. They will not be allowed to loiter in front of the building or wander the halls of the school. Parents are free to escort their student(s) to the cafeteria if necessary.

GOOD MORNING, TANANA!!!!

WHAT?

- A safe place for students to be before school
- Supervised “free time” including games, homework, movies, and crafts.

WHEN and Where?

- Monday through Friday
- 8 a.m. to 9:10 a.m. (morning bell)
- Cafeteria, Tanana Middle School

WHY?

- Keep students safe and out of trouble before the school day.
- Safe alternative for parents who have to get to work but don't want to leave their student home alone.
- Keep students from waiting for the bus in dangerously cold weather.

COST?

- **\$50 per semester, \$25 per quarter.**
- Students can't attend until the fee is paid.
- It is the same fee whether a person attends every day of the semester or just once.
- Make checks payable to Tanana Middle School.
- Students can turn in this form and the fee to the front office or to the Good Morning Tanana staff the first day they attend. A receipt will be given for the fee payment.
