## Expectations for student behavior during online instruction

At Hutchison High School all teachers have high expectations for students regarding engagement and attendance both during regular school and virtual instruction. Even during remote instruction, you are expected to be present and available during school hours. Do not plan to work, babysit, or otherwise not be 100% present. The following guidelines should help students understand teachers' expectations.

- Students will need a device that has camera and microphone capabilities, and that device will need to be charged and functioning. (All Hutchison students will be issued a Chromebook that meets these requirements).
- Students whose internet connection is not sufficiently strong may work from Nordale Education Center.
- Students are encouraged to have their cameras on.
- School-appropriate dress is expected.
- Students are expected to be sitting up, at an appropriate workstation, and attentive during class (not under the covers in bed).
- Students should make sure their background/surroundings that appear on camera are appropriate for school
- Students are expected to use their real names during Google Meetings and in all online activities.
- Students are expected to attend class every day, be on time, and stay for the duration of class (according to the Hutchison bell schedule).
- Students are expected to complete all class work and assignments during remote learning, as these will be counted in the course grade
- Students are expected to communicate with teachers via email for any needs or concerns outside of class
- If students are going to be absent, parents or guardians need to contact the school office at 479-2261 Ext. 0.
- It is the student's responsibility to contact their teachers to make up any work missed while absent. There is no guarantee that work will be provided for unexcused absences.
- Students are expected to participate in all class discussions and activities.
