Use simple data collection tolls to determine whether your management plan is working as effectively as you would like. You may use data to consider:

Which aspects of your classroom management plan are going well and should be maintained as is?

Whether there is one or more problem area that indicate you need to make adjustments to your management plan.

Whether the level of classroom structure you are currently using should be maintained or revised?
