

Here at Student Support Services, we strive to serve our staff, students, and families the best we can. We have made changes to the structure of how and where our social service managers are placed. They are now assigned to one school location, where they work out of five days a week, instead of being spread across multiple sites.

This new approach has allowed for more consistent and focused support in the designated schools. However, we understand that other schools may still require access to *emergent support* when needed. Emergent support is defined as the team/administrator has exacerbated all resources at the building level. This includes contacting the student's guardians and making your best effort to resolve their needs as well as establishing appropriate community connections for items like food boxes and winter gear.
