

TENTATIVE AGREEMENT


5400 Professional Development Funds:

The District will provide professional development funds in the amount of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) each year distributed evenly among all FPA members.

Principals shall apply to the Superintendent to use the funds using a District-developed approval form. The Superintendent shall have the authority to grant or deny any request; however, approval shall not be unreasonably withheld provided the request advances the goals or requirements of an approved professional development plan or additional goals identified during the course of the school year. Funds cannot be diverted to other uses, nor can they be used for equipment purchases. Travel and employee reimbursements must follow standard district practices. By April 1st, principals will notify FPA if they do not plan to use funds that year, at which point those funds will become unallocated and available for other appropriate expenditures for professional development. By April 1st, principals may submit to the FPA executive board a request for reimbursement based on actual or expected overages, to be considered for reimbursement from unallocated funds. Professional development funds must be spent or encumbered by the end of each fiscal year.
