Rules and Regulations

ELIGIBILITY

The Kids Voting Contest is open to all K-12 FNSBSD students and any K-12 students belonging to a Kids Voting North Alaska affiliate.

AGE GROUPS

Entrants compete in one of four-grade level groups: K-2, 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12.

RULES

- All work must reflect the theme of: **Your Voice, Your Vote!**
- All work must be the original work of a single person.
- Each work must be submitted with a **Kids Voting Contest Entry Form**.
- All entries become the property of the Kids Voting North Alaska.
- All work will be judged based on originality, composition, adherence to contest theme and guidelines.
- Each piece of work must be free of any political implication.
- Each piece of work must indicate on the back the name, age, grade, and school of student.

Podcasts: Entries can be no longer **one minute** and must be in **MP3** format.

Essays: Entries for **K-2** and **3-5** may be **no longer than 250 words**. Entries for grades **6-8** and **9-12** may be **no longer than 500 words**.

Posters: Posters must be **11x17 inches** in size.

Memes: Entries for **3-5, 6-8** and **9-12** must be able to be printed on **8x11 paper**. Acceptable to use <https://makeameme.org>, <https://www.memecreator.org/create>, etc.

JUDGING

- Submissions will be separated into grade level categories for judging.
- Submissions will be judged based on originality, composition, and adherence to the contest theme. Up to four finalists will be selected in each category and grade level.
- Finalists will placed on ranked choice ballots where students will be able to select the winners.

DEADLINES

- **All submissions are due to Kids Voting by October 12th.** Winners will be announced after November 8th.
