- Each piece of work must be free of any political implication (non-partisan, no candidates or issues) and must be appropriate for K-12 audiences.

- Poster:

Posters must be on plain paper (not lined) and at least 8.5 x 11 inches.

• Video:

Short format videos of 60 seconds or less.

• Essay:

Grades 3-5: 50 - 100 words Grades 6-12: 100 - 250 words.

• Meme:

All entries must fit on 8.5 x11 paper.

Questions to ponder as you create your entry based on the theme:

How does voting in local elections affect your life?

What do local elected officials do for you?

What's one thing you want changed in your community and how can voting make a difference?

ELIGIBILITY

The Kids Voting Multimedia Contest is open to all K-12 students within the Fairbanks North Star Borough.

AGE GROUPS

Entrants compete in one of four-grade level groups: K-2, 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12.

DEADLINE/SUBMISSION

All submissions are due no later than Wednesday, October 4th. Include a *submission form* with each entry.
