- ☛ Clothing and dress must be in accordance with the Lathrop and District Dress Code Policy, located in the student handbook
- ☛ No name stamp, embossing, photographer tag, or date stamp on the front of the photo
- ☛ No senior photos will be accepted after the deadline
- ☛ Students who meet the school district credit requirements for senior status are considered seniors for purposes of being included in the senior selection
- ☛ Students who do not submit a senior photo of their own choosing will have their student ID photo used in the section by default

## File Format for Senior Photos:

- Vertical Format
- 3x5 inches
- Resolution 300 ppi
- Save as JPEG
- Name the file: Last Name, First Name.jpeg  
Example: Smith,John.jpeg

### What is WUE?

The Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) is a tuition-savings program that makes attending out-of-state colleges and universities more affordable for students. Through WUE, you receive a reduced tuition rate, giving you more education options for your money. **Virtually all undergraduate degrees are available.**

### How does WUE work?

Participating two- and four-year public colleges and universities across the Western U.S. agree to charge out-of-state students no more than 150 percent of the institution's in-state tuition. Tuition savings may vary depending on the college or major.

**The bottom line: You save big with WUE and almost always pay less than out-of-state tuition.**

### How do I get started?

Check your eligibility by home state/territory, college and major through our online **WUE Savings Finder**.

# Alternatives to Four Year Colleges

## **Certification Programs**

Certification programs are short-term training programs or schools that focus on a specific area, which are usually cheaper than attending a four-year college. These programs can last from 3 months to 1 year. Certification programs are a great step in starting an education and getting a job, while allowing for further education if desired. They can also be more cost efficient than a 4-year degree.

Many certification programs are associated with a larger university or college. This means that you still need to pay attention to application and scholarship deadlines. If you are able, try to meet with a representative of the certification program you are interested in to make sure you meet all the necessary prerequisites to participate in the program.

Certifications can be obtained in airframe & power plant, early childhood education, accounting technician, medical assistant, applied business management, dental assistant, drafting technology, diesel/heavy equipment technology, power generation, and many other areas.

## **Vocational/Technical Schools (UAF CTC, among others)**

These are schools which focus on careers that are hands-on. Classes are focused around a specific career area. Programs are 6 months to 2 years long. Application requirements are generally less involved than traditional 4 year colleges.

Students attending vocational/technical schools can train for jobs in a wide variety of fields. Some examples include culinary arts, cosmetology, dental assisting/hygienist, automotive technology, information technology, healthcare occupations, heavy equipment operation, diesel mechanics, welding, construction, electrical, and small engine repair.

## **Joining the US Military**
