

Meal Distribution during Red (School Closure)

IN ORDER FOR THE DISTRICT TO RECEIVE FEDERAL REIMBURSEMENT DOLLARS FOR MEALS SERVED THROUGH ANY OF THESE PLANS, REGULATORY WAIVERS WILL HAVE TO BE APPROVED BY USDA OR THE STATE OF AK CHILD NUTRITION.

Meal service is compliant with National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP) regulations. Student meal eligibility (free, reduced, full pay) applies for all meal service plans.

Full price breakfast costs \$2.00 (elementary) and \$2.25 (secondary). Lunch costs \$3.50 (elementary) and \$3.75 (secondary). Reduced price is \$.40 for lunch and breakfast is FREE! Visitor or non-student prices are breakfast \$3.75 and lunch \$5.50.

If students are physically present in the school during closure, the green/yellow meal service plans will be utilized.

Breakfast and lunch offered at the same time (requires approved USDA waiver & will be applying)

Service will be out of the school's designated public entrance closest to the kitchen:

- Social distancing measures and mask wearing will be strongly encouraged
- No public will enter the school and serving will be set up outside on sidewalk for meal distribution
 - Nutrition Services (NS) staff will have food & beverage items inside the building with them
 - Customer arrives, NS staff will place meals requested on the serving table and complete required record keeping
 - Any conversation will take place with staff inside building and customer on far side of table
 - POS will be used to record meals served. If necessary, staff will record meals in Excel spreadsheet then enter into Primero at a later time (USDA requirement)
 - Meals will be distributed on a daily basis
 - Meals will not be cooked but sent with cooking and safe food handling instructions
 - Middle & High: multiple meals will have already been distributed on Mondays and Tuesdays; NS staff will have the "take away" meals list available to ensure students are not provided duplicate meals
 - Discovery Peak and Star of the North students will not be distribution locations and are able to pick up meals at other locations TBD

Meals will be distributed only to students enrolled in district schools participating in NSLP & SBP (NSLP regulation)

Parent/guardian pick up:

- Upon approved USDA waiver, parent/guardian pick up for student meals will be available. Parents are able to pick up meals for eligible students and may appoint 1 designated adult to pick up meals in the event they cannot. Parents are required to contact the kitchen manager or the NS Admin Office via email or phone to designate an alternate adult.
- Parent/designated adult will need to have student's ID # or DOB
- If parent does not have the student ID#, staff will need to verify in Powerschool or Primero

Meal distribution 9AM-1PM

Fresh Fruit & Vegetable Program (FFVP) will be served at the participating elementary locations if:

- School closure has occurred before produce has been distributed to the classrooms
- Product is located at the NS Warehouse or the schools' receiving area
- No parent/adult pick up is allowed - student must be present in order to receive it

Fresh Fruit & Vegetable Program is available at Salcha, Denali, Anne Wien, and Hunter only
