

2023 SWE Greatland Section Scholarship

The Society of Women Engineers Greatland Section is pleased to offer one \$2,000 and two \$1,500 scholarships to female high school seniors in Alaska planning to pursue a degree in engineering. Please fill out the attached application and submit to the SWE Greatland Scholarship Committee by **Wednesday**, **February 8**, **2023**.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be a young woman who:

- is a high school senior in Alaska
- intends to enroll in an ABET-accredited engineering program at a four-year college or university (engineering programs that are not ABET-accredited do not qualify). ABET accreditation provides assurance that a college or university program meets the quality standards of the profession for which that program prepares graduates. ABET-accreditation assures your entry to a technical profession through licensure, registration, and certification- all of which often require graduation from ABET- accredited program as a minimum qualification. Please note that many computer science programs are not ABET- accredited. Please be sure to verify with your collage the ABET- accreditation for any programs you are intending to pursue.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Applications will be evaluated based on:

- Essay
- Activities and Honors/Awards
- Letters of Recommendation
- Academic Performance
- Work/Technical Experience
- Engineering Fit
- Application Presentation

REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

- ☐ Two letters of recommendation
 - Recommendation letters must be mailed <u>with</u> the Completed Application Package, but <u>in a separate</u> sealed envelope with the author's signature on both the letter, and across the seal of the envelope.
 - One letter from an academic affiliated reference.
 - One letter from a non-academic affiliated reference (i.e., coach, employer, mentor, or volunteer organizer).
- ☐ Official high school transcript (no photocopies)
 - Transcript must be mailed <u>with</u> the Completed Application Package, but in a separate sealed envelope
 with the school administrator's signature or stamp across the seal.

Please be aware of the following deadlines:

February 8, 2023	Required application materials listed above must be postmarked by this date.			
April-May, 2023	Applicants will be notified of scholarship results. Scholarship recipients will receive a certificate at their senior awards ceremony.

- 2. Official school transcript must be mailed <u>with</u> the Completed Application Package, but in a separate sealed envelope with the school administrator's signature or stamp across the seal.
