3. A brief biography of your past accomplishments, your future plans and community service. **This should be a separate letter. Please do not consider your notes on your application to be your biography letter.**
4. Two (2) letters of recommendation from any of the following, non-family adults, who have known you for more than two years: teachers, employers, ministers, scout leaders. You have selected to print the Application for FRTA scholarship.

The deadline for **submitting this packet is March 15**. All applications **must be postmarked by midnight, March 15**. **Late mailings will not be considered for this award.**
