



## Parent Feedback - Parent Guide To the Online Feature

Parents and guardians can give feedback on teachers using paper forms or online through the PowerSchool Parent Portal using a web browser. The online Parent Feedback feature is not available when using a mobile app. The online feature is typically available from fall parent teacher conferences through mid-January.

The survey consists of 9 questions and also provides an opportunity to enter comments. Information you provide will assist principals in making fair and informed assessments on the performance of teachers and will contribute to the improvement of instruction in our district.

### Parent Feedback Online Through the Parent Portal

Navigate to [premier.k12northstar.org](http://premier.k12northstar.org) and sign in with your username and password.

- If you do not already have a parent account, please contact your student's school.
- If you have an account but have forgotten either the username or password, please try the **Forgot Username or Password** link.

From the menu items at left on your Parent Portal Start Page, open the **Communication** drawer and click on **Parent Feedback**.

If you have more than one student, all of your students and their teachers will be listed in the same Parent Feedback dashboard. Click on a teacher name to start the feedback process.
