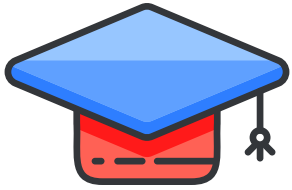

Why take the ParaPro Assessment?

In order to become highly qualified for an instructional paraprofessional position at a Title I school, such as a Classroom Tutor, Teacher Assistant, or Special Education Aide, you must have at least 48 college credits, an associate's degree or have passed the ParaPro Assessment.

Facts:

- The ParaPro Assessment measures the skills and knowledge in reading, writing and math possessed by prospective and practicing paraprofessionals. It also measures their ability to apply those skills and knowledge when assisting in classroom instruction. It is designed to satisfy the requirements of the federally legislated Every Student Succeeds Act.
- ParaPro Assessments can be scheduled by contacting the Human Resources Department at 452-2000x11326 or recruiting@k12northstar.org.
- Candidates will pay a total of \$95 on the day of the exam.
- The test takes approximately 2 1/2 hours.
- You must provide a valid picture ID for testing; a state driver's license is recommended.
- You should see unofficial scores at the end of the exam; official scores will be reported to you 2-3 weeks after testing.
- The passing score for Alaska is 459.
