**REQUEST FOR USE OF THE BOROUGH'S  
SCHOOL FACILITIES MAINTENANCE FUND**

WHEREAS, public safety, good maintenance, and energy conservation of all Fairbanks North Star Borough school buildings are consistent goals of the school district; and

WHEREAS, periodic investment in our buildings is one of the best ways to reach these stated goals; and

WHEREAS, the borough has established a school facilities maintenance fund (BSFMF) for these stated purposes; and

WHEREAS, state reimbursement of, up to, 70 percent of all expenditures for DEED approved projects is available; and


WHEREAS, this is an excellent long-term investment in public facilities and will ultimately reduce operational expenses and the need for facility capital funding; and

WHEREAS, the district would like to work with the borough on completing these major maintenance and construction projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Fairbanks North Star Borough Board of Education requests the Fairbanks North Star Borough Assembly and Mayor approve the following projects using the BSFMF as soon as possible:

- Additional funding for Weller Elementary Septic Replacement (\$235,000)
- Ticasuk Brown Elementary Roof Replacement and Exterior Upgrades Design (\$360,000)
- Three Classroom Additions to Badger Elementary (\$1,400,000)
