

Elizabeth Peratrovich Lesson Plans

Introduction/Hook: Grab students attention by beginning Elizabeth Peratrovich units with one or more of the following suggestions.

1. Display Tlingit or Haida materials
 - a. traditional hat (Alaska Native Education has a reproducible sheet to make a hat)
 - b. button blanket
 - c. art work
 - d. totem pole
 - e. other cultural piece.
2. Invite guests to share about their Tlingit or Haida cultures
3. Read a book about Tlingit or Haida cultures
4. Play Tlingit or Haida music
5. Read aloud an excerpt out of Elizabeth's Speech, obtain reactions
6. Distribution of Wealth activity
7. Play 3 min. video www.akhistorycourse.org/articles/article.php?artID=418
