Agenda Item 1: Welcome and Call to Order

Jason welcomed all the teachers and parents that attended and explained the purpose for the meeting.

Agenda Item 2: Head Teacher update

- a) Current enrollment: 198 students
- b) Budget Update
 - i. Enrollment numbers in 2020-2021 dictate 2021-2022 budget
 - ii. Need to keep full enrollment to maximize our budget
- c) Current Watershed Learning (FNSBSD will let Watershed know when in-person is permitted)
 - i. Full remote
 - a. District suggested active screen-time amounts
 - 1. K: 60-90 min
 - 2. 1-2: 90-120 min
 - 3. 3-4: 100-130 min
 - 4. 5-6 120-150 min
 - ii. A/B Hybrid (in-person and remote)
 - iii. Watershed is not participating in "e-Learning" (special program that has fees). Other district schools may be participating.
 - a. Watershed will use the terms "remote learning" or "distance learning/delivery" when referring to learning at home
 - iv. Teaching will be a combination of Synchronous learning (live Zooms) and Asynchronous (recorded video lessons)
- d) Determining A/B cohorts
 - i. Starting with middle school (44 students) because of 3 math courses, then try to accommodate siblings in lower grades.
 - ii. Jarrod teaching some of the middle school math
 - iii. A Cohort
 - a. Mon/Wed
 - iv. B Cohort
 - a. Tues/Thurs
- e) Remote Learning Fridays for everybody

- i. Teachers supported a 6-hr school day with the all remote learning Fridays
- ii. Friday is a student contact day (there will be work)
- f) School times: 8:30-2:30 (6 hrs).
 - i. This is 1 hour longer than other district schools
 - ii. Allows for recess, PE, outdoor classes/time, library (once a week)
 - iii. Afternoon shuttle bussing possible with this schedule
- g) This will be the schedule for the semester and the APC will reassess in Oct/Nov for spring semester
- h) Field trips
 - i. It's a possibility when in-person learning is allowed
